

RIA Environmental Risk Specialist (ERS) Advanced Designation Training Course

Prerequisite Checklist

Upload Resume	 Attendees must meet the following pre-qualifying requirements. Upload your resume indicating that you meet these requirements: High school diploma or equivalent education Training school that teaches courses similar to contents and restoration Five years of verifiable work experience or three years verifiable supervisory experience, project supervisor, estimator, consultant, inspector, restoration company manager, facility manager, restoration instructor. Note: This certification program is recommended for those with 5 years or more of active experience in the restoration industry.
