



RIA Fire Loss Specialist (FLS) Advanced Designation Training Course

Prerequisite Checklist

To be eligible to attend the FLS designation course, candidates must complete the prerequisite requirements in each of the following domains 30 days in advance of the course. A certificate of completion will be required as verification that each domain requirement has been satisfied. Upload proof of completion in the FLS course portal. Upload Resume	Attendees must meet the following pre-qualifying requirements. Upload your resume indicating that you meet these requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High school diploma or equivalent education • Training school that teaches courses similar to contents and restoration • Five years of verifiable work experience or three years verifiable supervisory experience, project supervisor, estimator, consultant, inspector, restoration company manager, facility manager, restoration instructor. Note: This certification program is recommended for those with 5 years or more of active experience in the restoration industry.
